

Scavenger Hunt Family Game

You and your family can collect items for your emergency supply kit during a family scavenger hunt. Make 2 copies of the Emergency Family Supply List.

Then separate your family into two teams with adults and kids on each team (if possible) and assign each group a different list of items. Set a timer and see who comes back first.

Below are some other things for your family to consider adding to its supply kit. Some of these items, especially those marked with a * can be dangerous, so please have an adult collect these supplies.

Supply List

- Rain Gear
- Mess kits, paper cups, plates and plastic utensils.
- Cash or traveler's checks, change
- Paper towels
- Fire Extinguisher
- Tent
- Compass
- Matches in a waterproof container or fire starter
- Signal Flare
- Paper, pencil
- Personal hygiene items including feminine supplies
- Disinfectant
- Household chlorine bleach* - You can use bleach as a disinfectant (dilute nine parts water to one part bleach), or in an emergency you can also treat water. Use 16 drops of regular household liquid bleach per gallon of water. Do not use scented, color safe or bleaches with added cleaners. (We recommend a portable water filter or Ion Stabilized Oxygen over bleach; as bleach is toxic if used too much, see <http://www.yourfoodstorage.com> for detail.)
- Medicine dropper
- Important Family Documents such as copies of insurance policies, identification and bank account records in a waterproof, portable container.
